## Purchasing from People with Disabilities Program Approval of Products Offered by Community Rehabilitation Programs Discussion Paper

## Background

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) administers the Purchasing from People with Disabilities (PPD) program. Texas Human Resources Code Chapter 122.007 requires TWC to determine the fair market price of all products manufactured or provided by individuals with disabilities and offered for sale to state agencies and political subdivisions by community rehabilitation programs (CRPs) participating in the PPD program. The PPD program, with assistance from the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts (Comptroller), reviews the cost analysis for new and revised product pricing submitted by the Central Nonprofit Agency on behalf of CRPs participating in the program. TWC Chapter 806 Purchases of Products and Services from People with Disabilities rule §806.52, Determination of Fair Market Value, requires the Comptroller to provide the PPD program with the necessary information and resources to comply with Chapter 122.007 to determine fair market price of products sold to state agencies or political subdivisions.

## Issue

Three CRPs presented five new products to be purchased through the PPD program. For each CRP, individuals with disabilities are paid above minimum wage and prices are competitive.

- Houston Lighthouse for the Blind presented one product: a disinfectant.
- Camino Real Community Services presented one product: a mesh-back office chair.
- West Texas Lighthouse for the Blind presented three products: one type of disposable face mask and two types of neck gaiters.

## **Decision Point**

Staff seeks direction on approving five new products presented by the three CRPs.
